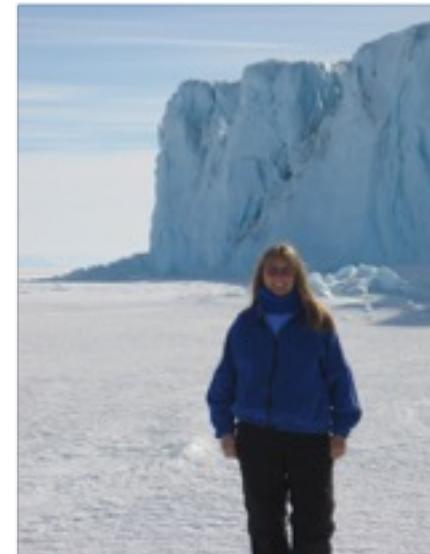
An Introduction to Antarctic Marine Ecosystems
